

Snowslide Injuries Claim Life Of North Carolina Woman

A woman buried 20 minutes under a 600-foot landslide that broke loose Tuesday at Park City died Wednesday at a Salt Lake City hospital.

Marilyn Harrell, 36, of Kinston, N.C., died about 9:25 a.m. from the effects of a heart attack and extreme loss of body heat suffered under the snowslide.

The other avalanche victim, 20-year-old Robert Beckett of Murray,

remained in satisfactory condition at Holy Cross Hospital. Mr. Beckett was buried by only several feet of snow and discovered quickly by one of his hands sticking out of the snow.

Mrs. Harrell apparently saw the avalanche descending toward her and tried to shelter herself under a ridge in the mountain. She was found curled up and not breathing and was rushed to Salt Lake City by medical helicopter.
